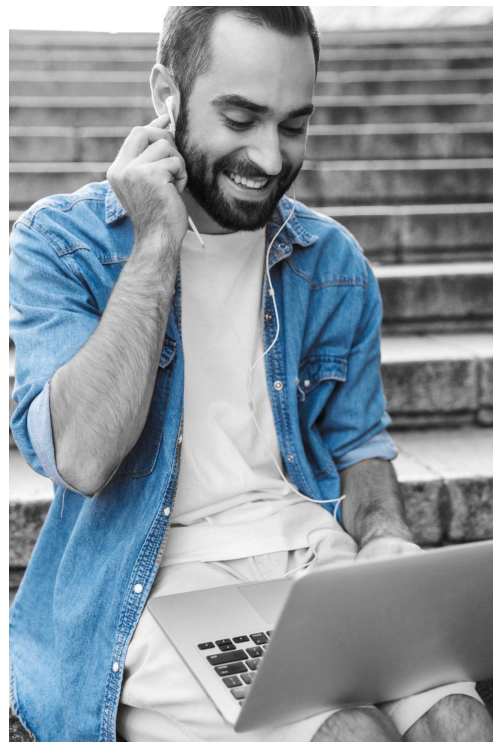
What is SmarterMeasure?

Why Measure Non-Cognitive Skills?

- Often the answer to “**why**” a student is not engaged in course (not motivated, no time to study, lack of technology skills, etc...)
- More **actionable** than other more fixed, predictive factors such as first generation, etc
- **Self-awareness** and **strategies for support** can make a big impact related to non-cognitive skills

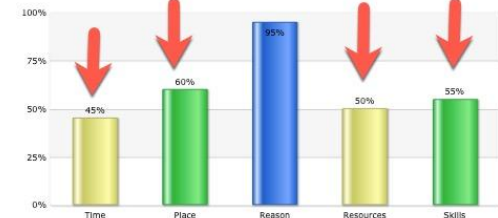

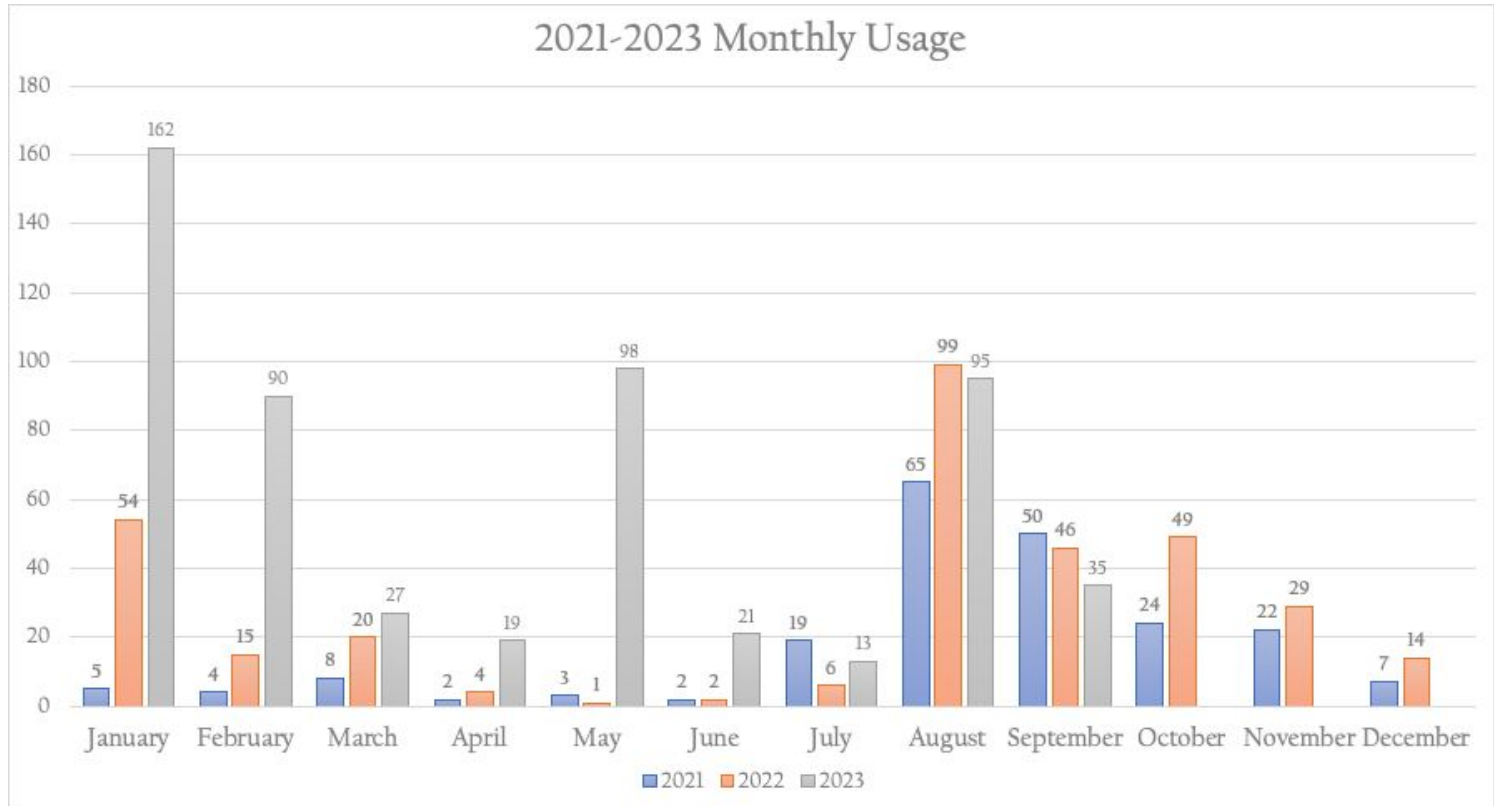

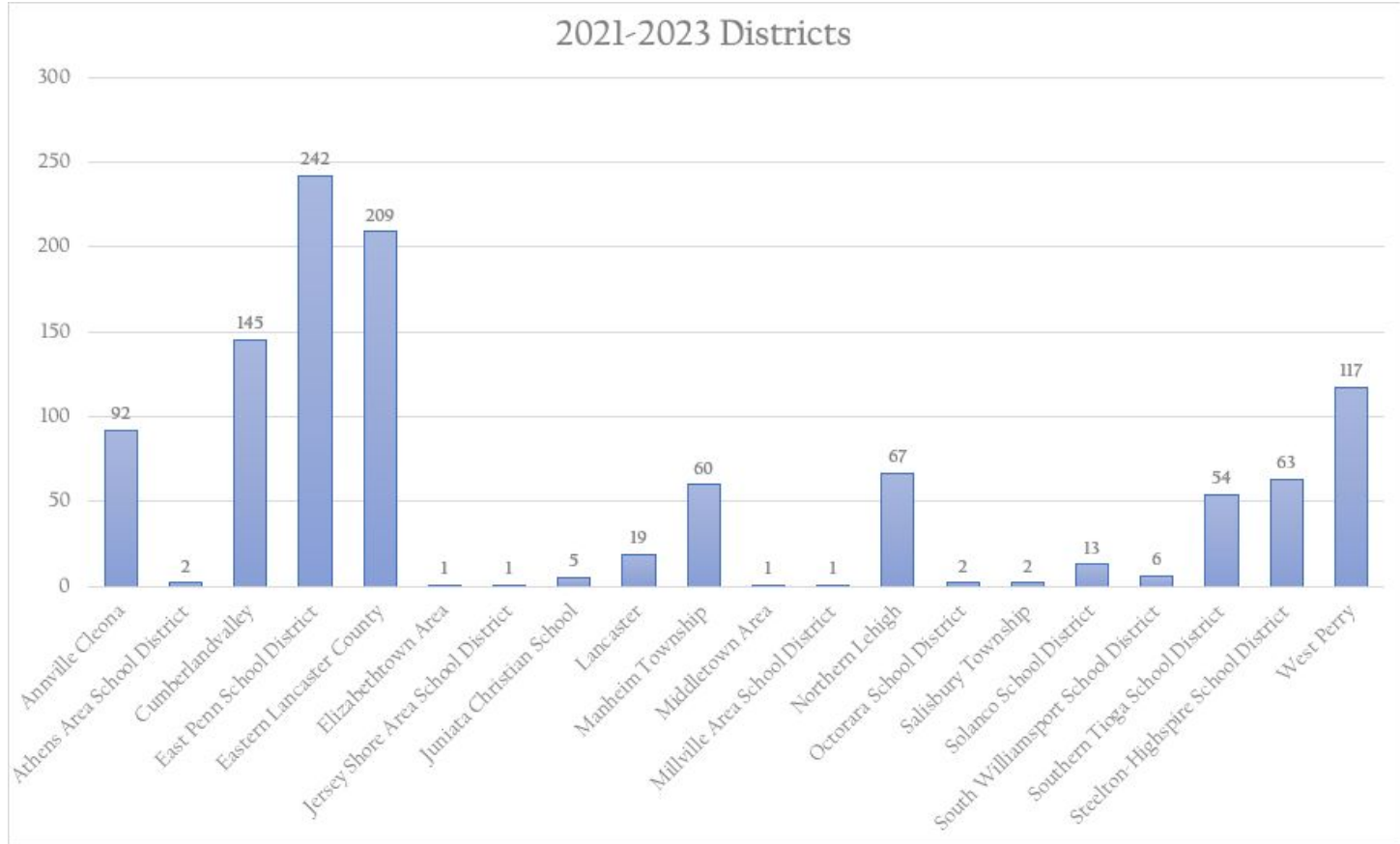

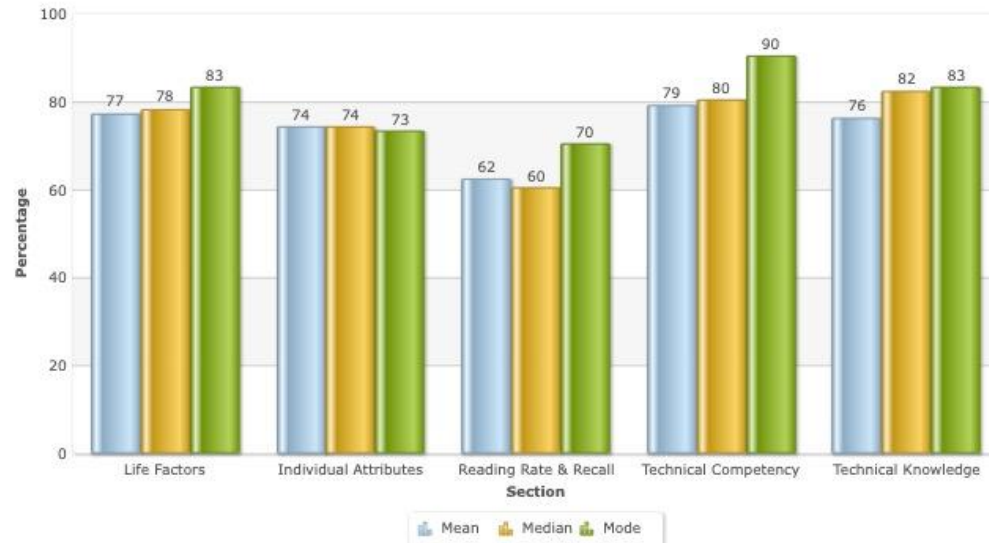

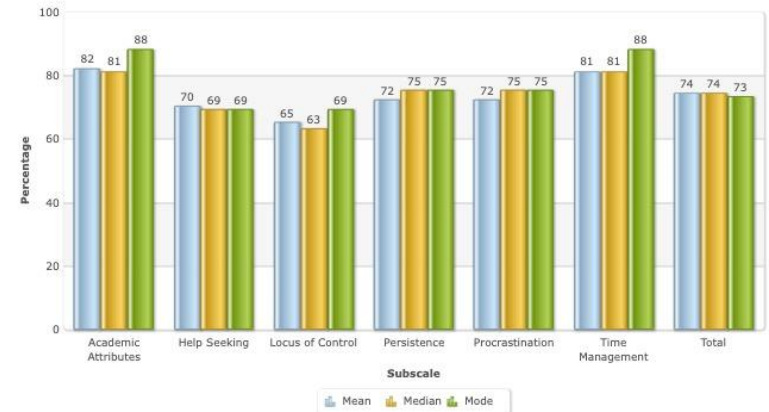

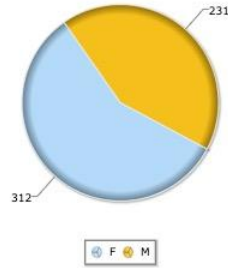

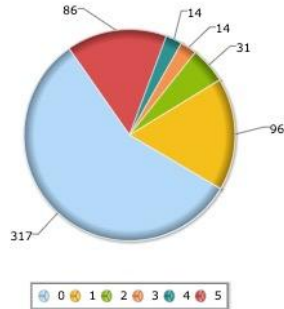

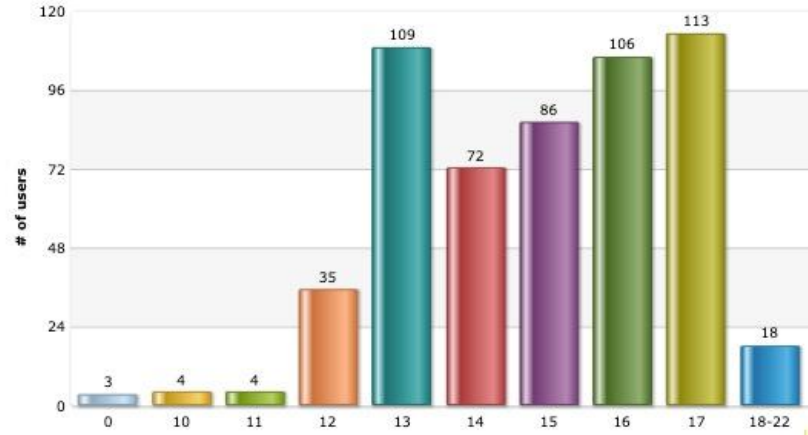
Gender Distribution



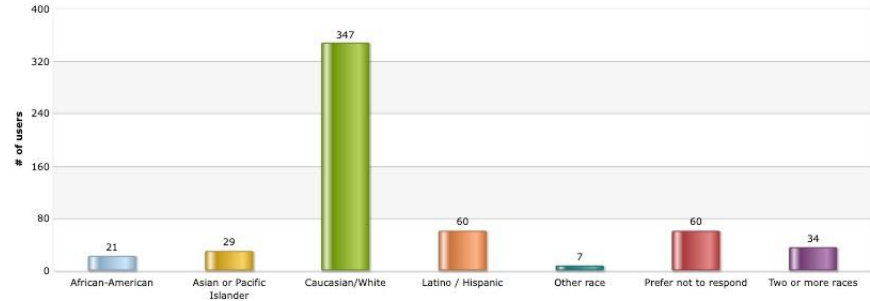
Online Courses Taken

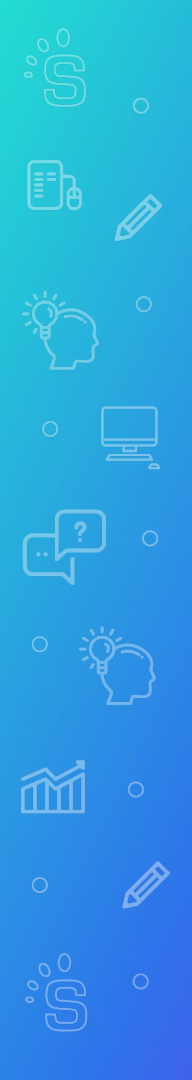

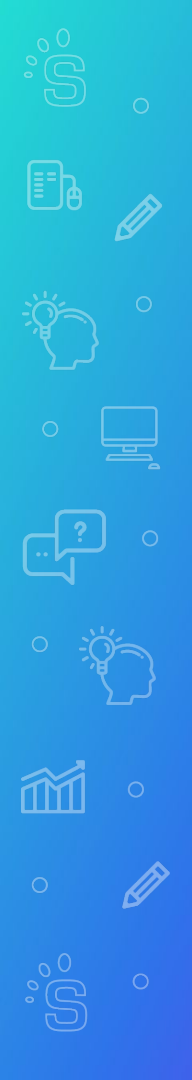

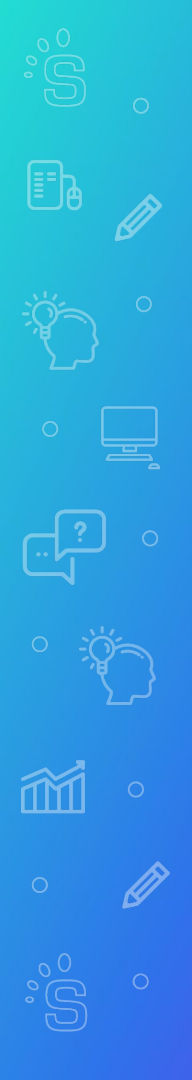
