



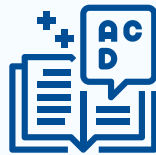

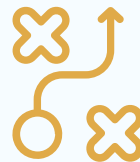
Are you looking for creative ways to increase student engagement while preparing students for the jobs of 2022 and beyond?
