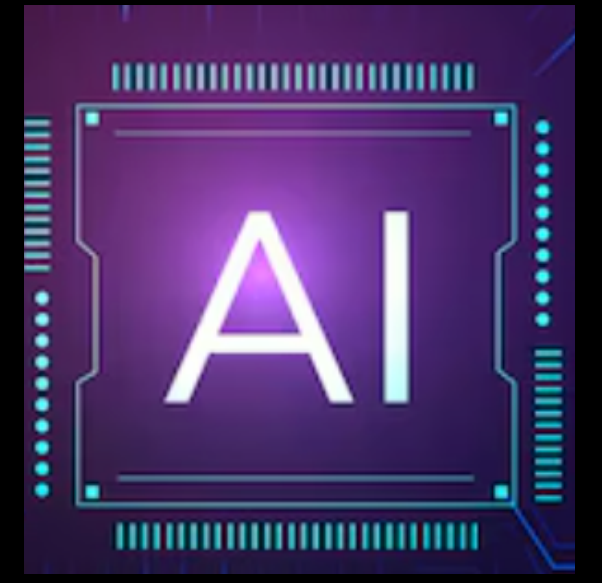


CITING *your* AI SOURCE



What Is an AI Citation?

An AI citation refers to the process of crediting the use of artificial intelligence tools, like ChatGPT, in research, academic writing, or other contexts, similar to how you cite any other source.

Why You Should Cite Your Sources

- Academic Integrity
- Attribution
- Transparency



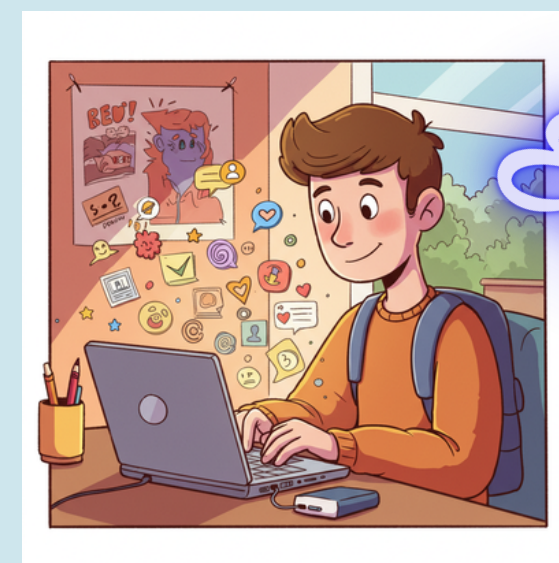
How To Cite Sources:

1. Identify the **AI Tool** used (e.g., ChatGPT, Midjourney, etc.) and its version.
2. Include the **Date** the AI tool was used to generate the content.
3. Provide a **URL** of the AI tool or a URL for the specific generated content.
4. Describe the **Content** that was generated (e.g., text, image, code).
5. Include the **Prompt** (if applicable).



Key Points to Remember:

- AI is not a "person" or "author"
- Be specific
- Verify and Evaluate
- Save your prompts and outputs
- Consult citation style guides (such as Purdue University)
