Act 158 of 2018 prescribed multiple pathways for students to meet PA assessment requirements for graduation. The state released the criteria for alternate assessments in spring 2020, which established alternative pathways to meeting statewide graduation requirements for students who are Career and Technical Education (CTE) concentrators. The requirements impact the class of 2022 and beyond.

Pathway 3: Career & Technical Education Pathway

Students will meet local requirements for academic content covered by the Keystone Exams for all subjects where they did not earn proficiency on the Keystone Exam.

AND

Either attain an industry-based competency certification related to the career and tech end (CTE) concentrator's program of study.

OR

Demonstrate a high likelihood of success on an approved industry-based competency assessment or readiness for continued meaningful engagement in the CTE concentrators program.
